You can use one or all of the AZ tax credits in a tax year for a dollar-for-dollar tax credit on your AZ tax return.

The credits are non-refundable, however if they are not fully used in a given year they carry forward for 5 years or until used (whichever comes first). The Military Family Relief fund credit is not available for carry forward, you must use it in the year of donation, but that shouldn't be a problem as you determine what order the credits are used to offset current year tax liability.
